**Lent begins on Wednesday 18th February.** There will be a Eucharist and Imposition of Ashes at both 10.00am and 7.30pm. I shall be preaching at both services. **The Lent course** this year will be based on a book by Henri Nouwen called *The Return of the Prodigal Son*. The course itself is based on Rembrandt's painting on the same subject. There will be an introduction to the work of Rembrandt with Matthew Firth at the Vicarage on **Thursday 19th February at 7.30pm**. The Lent course will then begin in the Birinus Room on **Wednesday 25th February starting at 7.30pm** and then continue each Wednesday through Lent.
